GUMF Raises Certificate Rates on March 1, 2022

Effective March 1, 2022, Georgia Methodist churches, ministries, and members that invest a minimum of \$5,000 in 1-, 2-, 3-, or 4-year fixed-rate certificates through the Georgia United Methodist Foundation (GUMF) will earn higher interest rates.* This rate change will apply to new certificates issued starting March 1. Please see new rates below. Your investment, which in turn provides funds for loans to Georgia-based churches and agencies, will help you save more while growing God's kingdom.

1-Year = 1.00% 2-Year = 1.15% 3-Year = 1.30% 4-Year = 1.50%

GUMF changes offered rates from time to time to move in line with market conditions. How can congregations invite new givers to begin their journey of generosity? Ann Michel of the Lewis Center staff outlines seven strategies more likely to connect with newer, younger givers.

Comprehensive research on giving patterns among American Christians has revealed that one in five gives nothing to church or other charities. This might seem shocking, but it's highly likely that the same pattern exists in your church. Congregations that study their own giving patterns typically discover that 20 to 30 percent of their members and participants are noncontributors.

United Methodist Higher Education Foundation Extends Scholarship Application Deadline

The United Methodist Higher Education Foundation (UMHEF) has extended its scholarship application deadline for the 2022-2023 academic year to March 15 after receiving several requests for more time to complete requirements during this challenging time.

Students who are members of The United Methodist Church and planning to attend a United-Methodist related school, college, university, or seminary full-time are eligible to apply. UMHEF awards scholarships within two main programs. The United Methodist Dollars for Scholars Program is a unique program that starts with a \$1,000 scholarship award from a student's local United Methodist church. UMHEF matches, raising the award to \$2,000. Participating United Methodist-related schools may also award, bringing the total to \$3,000. This award may also be matched for Georgia United Methodist students by the Georgia United Methodist Foundation (GUMF) for a possible total of up to \$4,000. Since 2011, GUMF has awarded 853 scholarships totaling \$726,700.
